1	Carnival 1-6	Al Rowad	Carnival is a creative, six-level course for young children starting to learn English as a first foreign language. Students will acquire skills of reading, writing, speaking and listening through a variety of activities like dialogues, songs, games and puzzles, which will motivate them to learn more.	
2	Kid's Box 2 - 4 (PB & AB)	Cambridge	This six-level course gives children a confident start to learning English, and makes lessons a joy for teachers. Perfect for general use. 3	Primary Colours 1- 6 Middle East Version	Cambridge	Primary Colours - a six-level course, engages students in thinking, doing and making things for themselves. Pupil's Books have engaging stories.
